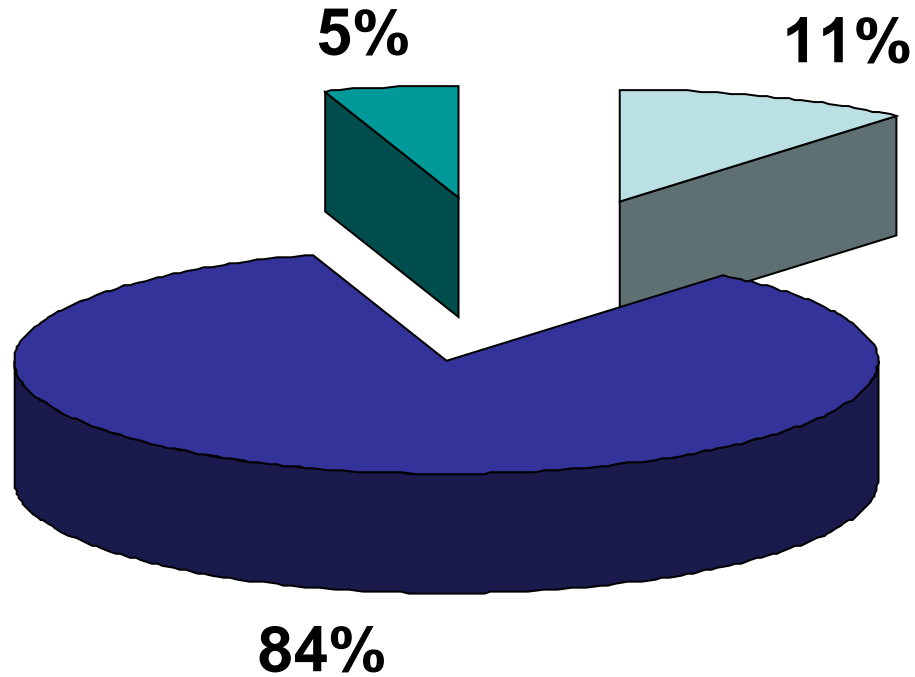

Eight Year Statistics

- **Fiscal 2007: 1252 locations inspected 158 violations 87 percent compliance rate**
- **Fiscal 2008: no underage compliance inspections conducted (inspector deployed)**
- **Fiscal 2009: 559 locations inspected 117 violations 79 percent compliance rate**
- **Fiscal 2010 : 400 locations inspected 115 violations 72 percent compliance rate**
- **Fiscal 2011: 300 locations inspected 63 violations 79 percent compliance rate**
- **Fiscal 2012: 300 locations inspected 63 violations 79 percent compliance rate**
- **Fiscal 2013: 200 locations inspected 71 violations 65 percent compliance rate**
- **Fiscal 2014: 200 locations inspected 32 violations 84 percent compliance rate**
- **Fiscal 2015 350 locations inspected 49 violations 86 percent compliance rate**
- **2010 the Department of Liquor Control conducted tobacco compliance inspections without any funding from the Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services.**
- **Prior to Fiscal 2010 Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services fully funded a position at the Department of Liquor Control to conduct underage tobacco inspections.**
- **Fiscal 2015 funding resumed by a grant from Maryland State Health Department**

Bills

33 - 12 Enacted: February 12, 2013

- Prohibit smoking on property owned or leased by the County;

56 - 14 Enacted: March 3, 2015

- Prohibit the use of electronic cigarettes in certain public places; prohibit the use of electronic cigarettes by minors;

15 - 15 Enacted: May 13, 2015

- Establish an excise tax on the distribution of electronic cigarette products;

14 - 15 Enacted: November 17, 2015

- Increase the maximum civil fine for distributing a tobacco product to a minor;

Resolutions

17 - 210 – Adopted: July 12, 2011

- Board of health regulation prohibiting smoking in certain common areas of multiple-family residential dwellings and certain playground areas.

17 - 1060 – Adopted: April 29, 2014

- Resolution to urge Merchants with Pharmacies to stop selling Cigarettes in Montgomery County Retail Outlets.
